



NEVADA NOTARIAL STANDARDS

Acceptable Identification

Notaries are required by Nevada law to verify signer identity through satisfactory evidence. The following forms of ID are accepted at all Ross & Associates appointments.

Primary Acceptable IDs (must be current)

- State-issued Driver's License (any U.S. state)
- State-issued Identification Card
- United States Passport or Passport Card
- United States Military ID (with photo)
- Permanent Resident Card (Green Card, Form I-551)
- Foreign passport **with a valid U.S. visa or entry stamp**
- Tribal Identification Card (federally recognized tribe)

ID Must Contain

- A clear photograph of the signer
- The signer's signature
- A physical description or biometric data
- An identifying serial or ID number
- An issue date and/or expiration date

Not Accepted

- Expired identification (regardless of type)
- Photocopies, digital images, or laminated printouts
- Social Security cards, birth certificates (identity documents only)
- Credit cards, employer IDs, gym or club cards
- Learner's permits without photograph

If you do not have an acceptable ID, notarization may still be possible using **two credible identifying witnesses** who personally know the signer and can each present acceptable identification. Please notify us in advance so we can prepare.
